Sample Will Wording

Residual Bequest:

Legacy Bequest:

"My estate trustees shall pay the sum of \$____ (or transfer assets with an equal value) to the Muskoka Woods Youth Foundation for such use and purpose as the Board of Directors may determine in their absolute discretion."

Legal Name:

The name you should include in your will to make a bequest is the Muskoka Woods Youth Foundation.

LIFE INSURANCE:

You can name the Muskoka Woods Youth Foundation as your beneficiary in a new or existing life insurance policy.

LIFE BENEFICIARY:

Make the Muskoka Woods Youth Foundation the beneficiary of your RRSP, RRIF, life insurance policy or TFSA, knowing your estate will receive a tax credit for other beneficiaries
